Increases awareness of school performance.

Provides schools with accurate ways to gauge and evaluate student achievement.

Indicates if students are making progress and learning the skills they need to be successful.

Helps parents see where their children excel and where they struggle.

### It is important to share the following data with families:

- State assessment results
- School report card information
- Individual student grades
- Credit accumulation for high school
- Progress reports
- Progress monitoring results
- Attendance
- Behavior incidents
- School perception
